A Biblical Example - The Shunammite Woman

This lesson is a type of character study. This is a very interesting and rewarding way of studying Biblical personalities. To encourage and aid you in doing other such studies on your own from the Bible, a sample outline you might wish to follow is included here:

Character Study Outline

- 1. List all the characteristics, good and bad, of the person to be studied.
- 2. Check a concordance to get verses of Scripture on these characteristics. (For instance: if the person was obedient to God, find a verse that speaks of the blessings of obedience; if the person lied or hurt others by the use of his tongue, find a verse that tells what God thinks of wrong use of the tongue; if the person believed God for great things, find a verse that tells the value God places on such belief, etc.)
- 3. Write a thumb-nail sketch or a brief summary of the person's life.
- 4. Write out problems. These can be things you don't understand about the person, or things you don't understand about God's dealings with him. State in the form of questions.
- 5. State what you think is the leading lesson taught by this life.
- 6. Make a personal application (The previous chapter explains how).
