II. Levels of spiritual growth.

A. Children.

- 2. There a lack of spiritual instruction, and they are prone to deception. (Ephesians 4:14)

B. Young men.

- 1. These are ones who have overcome Satan. (II Corinthians 11)
- 2. False doctrine does not entice this one anymore.
- 3. Spiritual pride is a problem for these.
- 4. He becomes increasingly able to battle temptation through awareness of God's truth. (Ephesians 6)

C. Spiritual fathers.

- 1. These are those who know the God behind the page.
- 2. They have intimacy with God and this is the great goal of their lives. (Philippians 3:10, Ephesians 1)
