C. Paul wrote a harsh letter, but false apostles remained in the community nonetheless.
D. He has undergone great suffering, but God has comforted him in his affliction so he blesses God.
II. Paul identifies God as the Father of all comfort.
A. This is the God revealed in Jesus Christ.
B. They are the same essence, but God is identified as the Father of Jesus Christ and his God. (John 1, 17, Ephesians 1:3, 2 John 1:3)
1. Jesus is God's equal.
2. Jesus has submitted to the Father in his humanity.
C. God's mercies are great. (2 Samuel 24, Micah 7, Romans 12:1)
D. God is the God of all comfort. This refers to God's provision of strength. (Isaiah 66)
