- II. False teachers are self-lovers who are a danger to the church. A superiority complex is the problem not an inferiority complex.
- III. They are covetous. Love of self leads to covetousness. (1 Timothy 6:10)
- IV. They teach disobedience to parents.
 - A. Disobedience to parents is a great problem in the church.
 - B. The family is disintegrating.
- V. They are thankless.
 - A. When we give a premium to self love, we end up with a thankless people.
 - B. It is not natural to love one another--God instills in the church a family kind of love.
 - C. It is the character of Satan to blaspheme and slander others.
- VI. False teachers do not have self-control. (Matthew 23)
- VII. False teachers are brutal.
- VIII. False teachers hate what is good.
- IX. False teachers are aggressive. (Acts 19:36)
- X. They loved pleasure rather than loving God.
