I. Introduction.

- A. Text: Revelation 14:12-13.
- B. The idea of blessed are the dead is unique.
- C. Blessed means happy. (Psalm 1:1; 2:12; 32; 41:1; 65:4; 84:4; 106:3; 112; 119:2; Proverbs 8:34, 32; Matthew 5; James 1:12)
- D. There are seven such beatitudes in the book of Revelation.
- E. The blessed are dead because they lived with perseverance and died with promise.
- II. The perseverance of the saints.
 - A.. This means that the elect will never lose their faith.
 - B. Their faith and salvation will endure.
 - C. It is also called eternal security.
 - D. Regenerate people will continue in their faith until the very end.
 - E. A huge congregation of martyred saints and preserved Jews will appear in heaven as those who have persevered. (Revelation 7)
 - F. God's side.
 - 1. God promises that faith lasts. (Psalm 37, Isaiah 43; 49; 51:6)
 - 2. God's purpose assures it. (John 6:37; Romans 8:28; 11:29)
 - 3. God's power guarantees it. (John 10, 2 Thessalonians 3:3, Jude 24, 1 Thessalonians 5:24)
 - G. Our side: we must endure. (Matthew 10:22; 24:13)
 - 1. Faith. (Colossians 1:21-23, Hebrews 3:14)
 - 2. Fear. (Revelation 2-3, Jeremiah 32:40)
 - 3. Love.
 - 4. Obedience.
 - H. The faith of true believers never dies. (Hebrews 11:13, 37; 12:1)

- J. The first evidence of salvation is obedience. (John 8:31; 14:21; 1 John 5:3)
- K. The second evidence of salvation is trust and loyalty to Jesus.

III. Death with promise.

- A. The believer does not fear death because with it comes promise. (Psalm 115:16, 1 Corinthians 15)
- B. The Spirit wants us out of the anguish of life.
- C. Believers are blessed in death because...
 - 1. It is rest.
 - 2. It is reward. (Hebrews 6:10, 2 Timothy 4, Revelation 20:12, 1 Corinthians 3)
