A. Self-worship gets in the way of true worship. (Matthew 6)
B. Each person must aim at God's glory.
1. Prefer God's will above everything. (Exodus 32:25)
2. Hurt when God hurts. (John 21, Psalm 69:9)
3. Be content to be outdone by others as long as God is glorified.
