- I. Introduction.
 - A. Text: Galatians 2:20.
 - B. God has a life for us to live.
- II. Christianity is about life, which is...
 - A. Fruitfulness.
 - 1. Paul's fruitfulness was based upon a divine revelation—fruit comes from God.
 - 2. We get hung up because often truth does not grip us.
 - 3. Fruitfulness is the outworking of that which is indwelling.
 - B. Forcefulness. Paul's Christianity was a holy aggression.
 - C. Faithfulness.
 - 1. Paul was basically concerned about the truth getting out.
 - 2. Nothing got in his way.
- III. Paul's life was by faith.
 - A. By grace we are saved through faith.
 - B. Fruitfulness, forcefulness and faithfulness only come by faith.
 - C. Faith is only as valid as its object. We must have faith in Jesus himself.
 - D. Jesus is very much alive.
