- I. Introduction. Text: Romans 1:16.
- II. The goals of BSU.
 - A. Trying to get the message of Jesus Christ to every person.
 - 1. People who do not believe in Jesus are lost and will spend eternity separate from God. (II Thessalonians 1:7-9)
 - 2. The day will come when Jesus will judge those who do not believe in God. (John 3:18)
 - 3. Jesus is the only cure. (John 3:17)
 - 4. God reveals himself through conscience, and through creation. (Romans 1:18)
 - 5. If man responded to God through His revelation to conscience and through creation he could be saved, but there has never been any case that this has been true.
 - 6. A person is lost by rejecting the light given by God, and he stays lost by continuing to reject Jesus.
