 - B. God wants us to be growing in the likeness of his Son Jesus. (Romans 8:29)
 - C. God wants us to glorify him through fruit. (Isaiah 43:7; John 15:8; Galatians 5:22-23; John 15:16; 17:18; 20:21; Luke 19:10)
 - D. Everyone who names the name of Jesus is called to ministry. (Judges 3:31)
 - E. God gives us all the power we need to accomplish the task.
