I. Introduction.

II. Second Corinthians 5:10 is not a judgment seat for believers to be condemned but to be rewarded. (Romans 8:1)

III. Address the belief that baptism is necessary for salvation by asking about the thief on the cross who was promised heaven without being baptized.

IV. Leave dissentious self-righteous members of the church alone.

V. Develop a life-long mentoring relationship by finding the right person you could follow and asking him.

VI. A pastor's main objective is to keep the machinery running, so we cannot expect him to focus on man to man ministry.

VII. Pray for the person who has become apathetic in their Christian life and stand by him.

VIII. It is not the nature of something that determines its spirituality but its source. (John 3:6)

IX. Fire employees who are not doing right.

X. Rekindle your love for Christ by recognizing your problem.

XI. Get to know a person you are dating and keep it above the neck and below the knees.

XII. Accountability depends upon what a group agrees upon. (Proverbs 4:1)

XIII. What we believe will determine what we do.

XIV. The biggest concern about Christians in disciple making ministry is being luke-warmed and a lack of understanding of what God is doing in the world. (Revelation 3; 1 John 1:9; Matthew 24)

XV. Philosophy of ministry: to know, love and glorify God, to be used of him, to raise up qualified laborers in significant numbers as fast as possible to help fulfill the Great Commission.

XVI. If you have a drinking problem, admit your problem and go to AA. Get help if you need it.

XVII. The price is never too high to take care of your family. Take the jobs you need to provide.

XVIII. Confession is asking God for forgiveness and agreeing with God. (Isaiah 59:1-2; Psalm 66:18; 32:6)

XIX. Everybody has at least one gift. Gifts should not be an excuse to serve in other ways. We can know our gifts by trying things out. (1 Corinthians 12; Hebrews 1)

XX. Jesus died because it was necessary for him to die. (Leviticus 17:11; Hebrews 9:22; Habakkuk 1:13; Revelation 5)

XXI. People of eastern religions are following after demons and cannot be discipled unless saved first.
