XXIV. We should be concerned about the New Age movement. Reject everything that does not emphasize God.

XXV. Spiritual maturity is doing what God wants the way he wants.

XXVI. We should be in fellowship with anyone who can say Jesus Christ is Lord.

XXVII. Do not seek to disciple your boss.

XXVIII. We groan by realizing the condition of this world and what is happening around us. (2 Corinthians 5:1-4)

XXIX. When children do not follow the Lord, know that children must become responsible at some point for themselves, do not allow the public to lay a guilt trip on you, know what God thinks is greater and do not let your children knock you off the path God intended to put you on.
