- A. The disciples were not to gain power the same way that the world did. (John 18:36)
- B. It is not wrong to seek reward. It is wrong to seek it for selfish reasons.

- D. To desire leadership and service is a good thing. (1 Timothy 3)
- E. God is looking for people who are willing to serve. (1 Corinthians 4)
- F. Let every day be a day of humility.
- G. The gist of greatness is service.
- H. Criticism and fatigue are threats to faithful service.

- A. Jesus is the example.
- B. We are to follow his pattern.
- C. Jesus served--even to the point of giving his life. (Luke 22:20, John 15:14)
- D. Jesus' death was more than an example--it was ransom. (1 Peter 2, Romans 8, 1 Corinthians 6, 1 Peter 1:18)
- E. Christ became a ransom for all. Because of this God glorified him. (Philippians 2)
