A. Short term values. (Mark 4:19)

- 5. The ultimate test of values is whether they last. (I John 2:17)

B. Past failures.

- 1. God loves to use failures.
- 2. The past is past.
- C. Being self-absorbed.

1. The self-absorbed life is a miserable life. (Proverbs 14:14)

2. Jesus teaches that one must give his life away in order not to lose it.

D. Fear.

1. This is the most common barrier.

2. God commits Himself to our responsibility when we commit ourselves to Him. (Matthew 6)

V. What one must do to commit oneself to God.

A. Consider the cost. (Luke 14)

1. We give up the right to do whatever we want to do with our lives.

- 2. We give up control of our resources.
- 3. We give up the pursuit of the world's values.

4. If we do not give up our lives to Christ we lose our purpose, the joy of expressing our God-given shape and eternal salvation.

- 5. There is a price to pay on either side. (Romans 12)
