- I. Introduction.
  - A. Many people say they know God.
  - B. Some of these simply know about God and do not really know God.
  - C. We need to know God in a relationship that He Himself will acknowledge.
- II. Knowing God begins with a genuine experience with Jesus Christ. (1 John 1:1-4)
  - A. It is a personal experience. (1 John 1:1)
  - B. It is a powerful, life-changing experience. (1 John 1:2)
  - C. It is a purposeful experience:
    - 1. To share to Christ with others. (I John 1:3)
    - 2. To strengthen Christians who do know Him.
    - 3. When we fulfill our purpose (1 & 2), then we experience satisfaction in our Christian life.
- III. Knowing God continues to grow as we have a genuine examination of the Scriptures. (1 John 1:5-10)
  - A. Through the Bible, you can know the character of God.
    - 1. We will know God through His Word.
    - 2. We need daily examination of His Word.
  - B. We can have communion with God. (1 John 1:7)
    - 1. By kneeling at the cross of Jesus Christ:
      - a. For forgiveness.
      - b. To maintain fellowship by confessing our sins.
    - 2. When we walk in the light:
      - a. Obedient to His Word.
      - b. Surrendered to His will.

IV. Knowing God involves a genuine expression of holiness:
A. Purity. (1 John 2:1)
B. Humility. (1 John 2:1)
C. Obedience to God's Word. (1 John 2:3-4)
D. Maturity. (1 John 2:5-6)
E. Unity with other believers. (1 John 2:9)
F. Loyalty to Jesus Christ. (1 John 2:15)

f) <b>Apply</b> the Word to your daily life.
g) <b>Proclaim</b> the Word to others as you are going.
