I. Introduction.

- A. Text: Daniel 12:4-14.
- B. The only true source of knowledge about the future is the Bible, and Daniel is one of the great prophetic books about the future in the Bible.
- C. God tells us about the future to authenticate his Word, to reveal his sovereignty, to motivate and comfort his people and to admonish the wicked.
- D. The Lord clarifies some final features in this section of Daniel.

II. The content sealed.

- A. The time of the end refers to the Great Tribulation.
- B. The information was to be preserved until the time of Revelation.
- C. Many during the time of the tribulation would be looking for information, but Daniel would not be able to reveal it all.
- D. However, Daniel would be used to turn many to righteousness at the end.

III. The chronology set.

- A. God swears that the Antichrist would reign for three and a half years.
- B. The people will be so crushed that Israel will only look to Christ. (Revelation 13, Matthew 24:39)
- IV. The confusion stated. One cannot fully understand until the Tribulation time arrives.
- V. The cleansing secured.
 - A. Many will be purified. A reborn remnant will be born during this period. (Zechariah 13:8)
 - B. There will be thirty days to finish the purging to determine who will belong in the Millennial kingdom.
- VI. The commendation sworn.
 - A. Responsibility.
 - B. Resurrection.
 - C. Reward.
