- I. Introduction.
  - A. Text: Romans 12:1-2.
- II. The body of Christ is built for service.
  - A. The people of the church bring their own unique gifts to contribute to the whole.
  - B. Every person in the church should be contributing to one another.
  - C. The body of Christ needs everyone to fully function.
- III. Service is always the byproduct of worship. Life must first be given.
  - A. The key to service is giving to God.
  - B. Powerful living is giving all to God.
- IV. Elements of sacrifice.
  - A. Present your soul to God.
  - B. Present your body to God. (Psalm 15:12)
    - 1. Present yourself as a living sacrifice.
    - 2. Present yourself as a holy, yielded sacrifice to God.
  - C. Present your mind to God.
    - 1. This means not to be conformed to the world thinking.
    - 2. This is avoided by the renewal of the mind. (Joshua 1:7, Psalm 119:11, Colossians 3:10)
  - D. Present your will to God.
    - 1. Seeking God's will becomes your top priority.
    - 2. Seeking his will is good, pleasing and perfect.
