I. Introduction.

- A. Question: what will the redeemed do in heaven?
 - 1. Believers will never have to struggle with sin again.
 - 2. There will be no more pain, needs or lack of joy.
- B. What will we do?
- II. We will adore God in Christ forever.
 - A. The end of salvation is true worship. (John 4)
 - B. Praise will be uninterrupted. (Revelation 4, 15, 19)
- III. We will reign with Christ.
 - A. This means that we will have responsibilities.
 - B. We are always living with a sense that our work is not what we want it to be--this will change.
 - C. We have an inheritance that has to do with the sphere of our authority. (1 Peter 1:3)
 - D. The authority Christ was given was over us. (Revelation 5)
 - E. We will each have an area of responsibility. (1 Corinthians 6)
 - F. Rule will be proportionate to faithfulness in this life. (Matthew 25:14, Luke 19:17)
 - G. We will be able to enjoy doing jobs to perfection forever. (Revelation 3:21)
