- B. There are six things that will keep you from finishing the race.
- II. Abundance of idleness. We need to be fervent in discipline. (Ezekiel 36:9, Proverbs 10:4)
- III. Busyness. (I Kings 29:40)
 - A. Lazy people create the illusion of commitment by being busy.
 - B. We cannot be too busy to listen to Jesus. (Luke 10; 5:15-16; Acts 10)
- IV. Prayerlessness. (Isaiah 64:7)
 - A. We need to claim promises for our lives. (Galatians 3:29)
 - B. Many problems could be avoided in our lives by asking God.
- V. Short-sightedness. (Hebrews 12:16, Colossians 4:14, Philemon 24)
- VI. Indecisiveness. (I Kings 18:21)
 - A. We cannot have two masters.
 - B. We must decide whether Jesus is the Lord of our lives and whether the Scriptures are authoritative and sufficient.
- VII. Unconfessed sin. (Judges 16:40)
 - A. Sin has four steps: I saw, I coveted, I took, and I hid. (Joshua 4)
 - B. Sin begins with the mind's eye or physical eye.
