## The Word of God Lauren Libby


- I. Why Am I doing what I'm doing? (Mark 4:1-20)
  - A. After college will I still walk with the Lord?
  - B. Will I maintain my walk with Christ?
  - C. Parable of the sower:
    - 1. Some seed fell on the path.
    - 2. Some seed fell on the rocky ground with no root (hear the Word, but develop no roots; fall away with tribulation).
    - 3. Some see fell among thorns (hear the Word, but other things choke it out).
    - 4. Some seed fell on good soil and brought forth a fruit (hear the Word, accept it, and bear fruit)
    - 5. Jesus met with disciples and explained parable.
  - D. What are the commonalities among the soils?
    - 1. Each has a sower.
    - 2. Each has a seed.
    - 3. Each has different qualities.
- II. God uses His Word to encourage us (Isaiah 41:10)
  - A. Jesus doesn't speak to us audibly.
  - B. The Bible is God's medium to us.
  - C. The Pharisees knew the scripture, but they rejected Christ.
  - D. God comes to us through the Bible (Psalm 40:7).
- III. Attitudes towards the Bible expressed through the Parable of the Sower
  - A. The path (Mark 4:15).
    - 1. Hardness comes through a lack of response to God.
    - 2. Sin will harden our consciousness towards God.

B. The rocky soil (Mark 4:16).		
1. The hearer of the Word has no root.		
2. Could be the result of not spending time in the Word on a daily basis.		
3. Tribulation and Persecution will come.		
a) Often brought by God.		
b) May come about through our own disobedience.		
C. The thorny soil (Mark 4:18).		
1. Delight of riches may choke out the Word (Mark 8:36).		
2. Cares of the world may choke out the Word.		
3. Busyness may choke out the Word.		
D. The good soil (Mark 4:20).		
1. The hearer accepts the Word and grows fruit.		
2. God is glorified when fruit is bore (John 15:8).		
3. Fruit comes as we respond to the Word of God.
