I. Introduction.

- A. People really need to be committed to their ministry and know that it is what God wants them to do so that they are not robbed of joy. (Philippians 1)
- II. God gives competence so we need to keep doing what we are doing. (2 Corinthians 3:5-6, Galatians 6:9)
- III. Navigator progress, goals and prayer requests.
- IV. Laborers.
 - A. The Navigator focus.
 - B. Definition: a laborer is a disciple aggressively involved in evangelizing the lost and establishing the saved.

V. Equippers.

- A. Laborers equipping disciples to become laborers.
- B. Multiplication and reproduction are involved in this. (2 Timothy 2:2, 1 Thessalonians 1, John 17:20, Matthew 28:19, John 12:24, Isaiah 59:21)

VI. Vision and aim.

- A. Local Navigator ministries have different visions but the same aim.
- B. The primary aim of the Navigators is to multiply laborers in every nation, thus helping to fulfill Christ's Great Commission by evangelizing, establishing and equipping.
- C. There are limits on what one can do and cannot do. This is determined by the aim.
- VII. Guidelines for staff people in the community ministry.
 - A. They should be guided by the aims and essentials of the Navigator ministry.
 - B. Their ministry should be characterized by evangelism and discipleship.
 - C. They should not be too involved in secondary objectives.
 - D. Their ministry should be primarily to the 18-35 year old age group.
 - E. Their ministry should not be primarily centered in a local church.
 - F. They should not start local churches.
 - G. Their ministry will report and be held to the same standards of other Navigator ministries.

VIII. Definition of a community ministry: a disciple making ministry with people wherever they are at.
