- I. Introduction.
- II. Jesus loves us just as we are. (Jeremiah 31:3, John 9:25)
- III. Jesus loves everyone else just as much as He loves us. (I Timothy 2:4, II Peter 3:7, Romans 15:7)
 - A. Since Jesus received us just as we are, we are to receive others unconditionally also.
 - B. One must accept himself unconditionally in order to receive others unconditionally.
 - C. Some cannot tell the difference between the conviction of the Spirit, which is firm and specific (I John 1:9), and the accusation of the devil, which is vague.
- IV. We are God's method of reaching other men and women. (II Corinthians 5:14)
 - A. Identification with people has to do with self-acceptance.
 - B. We need to be real with people to identify with them. (Luke 22:28)
 - C. Ask the Lord to enable you with people. (John 1:14, I Thessalonians 1:5-6)
- V. Things one must do in evangelism.
 - A. Testimony.
 - 1. One must be able to communicate his personal experience with Christ. (I John 1:3)
 - 2. One must share what his life was like before Christ (B.C.), how one met Christ and one's personal testimony today. (Acts 26:1-28)
 - 3. Write your testimony out, practice it and give it to a good friend for critique.
 - B. The gospel about who Jesus is, what He did and why He did it.
 - 1. The Spirit testifies to the person and work of Jesus Christ. (John 15:26)
 - 2. One must use the Bible because it is the sword of the Spirit. (Ephesians 4)
 - 3. The man of the truth hears Jesus' voice. (John 18:37, II Thessalonians 2:10)

- 4. The bridge illustration.
 - a. Man is separated from God because of sin. (I Timothy 2:5-6, Romans 3:23)
 - b. The wages of sin is death and judgment. (Romans 6:23, Hebrews 9:27)
 - c. There are many false bridges: religion, good works (Isaiah 64:6), baptism, church membership, etc. (Romans 3:20)
 - d. The one that hears and believes Jesus Christ is saved. There is no condemnation in Jesus Christ. (John 5:24; 1:12; Revelation 3:20; Matthew 12:30; I Corinthians 15:3-4; 5:17)
