  - A. The preceding action is to go.
  - B. The main action is to make disciples.
  - C. Baptizing and teaching is part of the process of making disciples.
  - D. Obedience needs to be taught. (Matthew 23:3; James 2:10; John 14:15-23; 15:10; 8:51-55; 17:6, 1 John 2:3-5; 3:22-24; 5:3)
- III. The objective of the Navigators is to fulfill the Great Commission by multiplication. Multiplication is best accomplished through a man-to-man emphasis.

  - A. A decision makes one saved.
  - B. Follow up and training make a disciple.
  - C. New converts start the process again.
  - D. Zero in on two or three who will make disciples on their own.
- V. Essential ingredients for a disciple maker.
  - A. A heart for men. (John 17, 2 Timothy 1:2-3, 2 Corinthians 8:3-4)
    - 1. Show him your love.
    - 2. Create a safe atmosphere to share.
    - 3. Let them know you are available.
    - 4. Pray for men individually.
    - 5. Accept a man as he is.
    - 6. Live transparently.
    - 7. Sharpen your vision.
    - 8. Take a responsibility for a man's growth.
    - 9. Trust him.
    - 10. Be an encourager.
