 - D. One needs to go to his brother and make sure things are right always exercising a conscience void of offense against God and man.
- IV. Satan uses individualism. (Romans 12)
 - A. One ought to be an individual person, but not individualistic.
 - B. We are to think soberly of ourselves within the Body of Christ.
 - C. Individualism is pride.
 - 1. One is to think of himself in respect to the measure of his gift.
 - 2. One is not to think more highly or lowly about himself than he is.
 - D. We are one body in Christ so we ought to act like it.
 - 1. We cannot give God satisfaction if we ignore the Body of Christ.
 - 2. The Body means a great deal to God and it ought to mean a great deal to us.

E. A person in isolation cannot fulfill God's purpose - the Great Commission was given to a group of people. (1 Corinthians 12:20-21)
