      - a. Evil thoughts.
      - b. Lying.
      - c. Lust.

- d. Anger, etc. needed to be conquered one at a time.
- c. As we get victory one by one we become strong.
- d. But things I thought I had victory over years ago have a way of cropping up again and again.
- e. I never become strong in myself; I only become strong in Christ.
