I. A disciple takes up the cross daily – Luke 9:23
II. Prays and fasts – Luke 11:1
III. Full of joy and the Holy Spirit – Acts 13:52
IV. Abides in and Obeys the Word of God – John 8:31-32; Colossians 3:16
V. Bears fruit – John 15:8; John 15:16; Matthew 4:19
VI. Loves others – John 13:35-45
VII. Puts Christ first – Luke 14:26; Luke 14:33; Matthew 6:33
