- I. Introduction. (Ephesians 5:23-25)
- II. A husband's responsibility as leader is to watch out for the welfare of those under him and to help them accomplish the objectives or mission God has given. (Psalm 78:70-72)
 - A. Objective 1: exemplify Christ in your home.
 - B. Objective 2: propagate the earth with godly offspring. (1 Thessalonians 2:18-19)
- III. Principles for leadership by which husbands should operate. (Joshua 1:8; Psalm 103)
 - A. Know your wife in order to look out for her welfare.
 - B. Keep your wife informed. Husbands should take the initiative in communication.
 - C. Set the pace spiritually.
 - D. Make sound and timely decisions. (1 Corinthians 14:33; Romans 14:27; Acts 16:6-7; Philippians 4:6-7)
 - E. Determine your wife's gifts and capabilities and encourage them accordingly.
 - F. Seek responsibility and take responsibility for your actions.

IV. Headship.

- A. It is not dictatorship. It is a leadership of love.
- B. It is not superiority and inferiority. It is equality before the Lord and functional differences. (1 Corinthians 11:3)
- C. It does not mean the husband makes all the decisions. This is where discussion and delegation comes in.
- D. It does not mean the husband is always right. It simply means he is responsible.
- E. It is never to be demanded.
