- I. God is excellent, all His attributes are excellent, and all that He does is excellent
  - A. If we are to reflect God (and be His temple) all we do must be excellent (I Corinthians 6:19)
    - 1. For this reason we are called to be perfect (Genesis 17:1; Matthew 5:48)
  - B. Excellence is a mark of Christian character because it's a mark of Christ
  - C. To be like Christ (excellent) is to "make the back door look like the front door"
    - 1. There is no aspect of life, no matter how small, that this should not affect
  - D. The greatest way to maintain excellence in our lives is to surrender our own will and depend on Jesus to work His excellence in us (Hebrews 13:20-21)
- II. What can make us better reflect Christ's excellence?
  - A. We must recognize our own weakness (2 Corinthians 12:9)
  - B. We should get others praying for us (Colossians 4:12)
  - C. Someone may share God's word with us (I Thessalonians 3:10)
  - D. We can get insight from the word directly (2 Timothy 3:16-17)
  - E. Suffering produces excellence (I Peter 5:10; James 1:2-4)
  - F. God will give us a desire for a holy life (2 Corinthians 7:1)
  - G. God will give us a desire for fruit that is brought forth to perfection (Luke 8:14)
- III. What are some areas in life to strive to manifest the spirit of excellence?
  - A. In your witness (Acts 14:1)
  - B. In the training of others (I Corinthians 14:12; I Corinthians 3:5-15)
  - C. In the serving of others (Matthew 25:14-30; 2 Corinthians 4:5)
    - 1. What are our motives for serving?
      - a) God demands a proper attitude for acceptable service
      - b) Only God can make us have pure motives
      - c) Ask Him for a spirit of joyful response to His commands, which is excellence
