- I. Introduction.

  - B. The key to success in the ministry is having a clear conscience before God and man. (Acts 24:16)
    - 1. A fundamental basis of Christian fellowship is the cleansing of Christ's atonement. (1 John 1:9)
    - 2. There is freedom in a clear having a clear conscience.
  - C. With the fear of the Lord it is only God who is keeping minutes. (Malachi 3:16)

	B. Wherever you go, God will be with you.
	C. Only be strong and very courageous. (Joshua 1)
	D. Courage is a sensibility as to the danger involved and a mental willingness to endure.
