I. Introduction.

- A. We have an extraordinary call to an extraordinary commitment.

- B. Part of obedience is reaching out to others. (Colossians 1:28-29)
- C. God wants us to be radiant. Jesus is the radiance of God. Our radiance is to be reflected by his radiance through the Word of God.
- D. We must choose to be intimate with God.
