Mark 2:27-28 (NRSV) "Then he said to them, "The sabbath was made for humankind, and not humankind for the sabbath; so the Son of Man is lord even of the sabbath."

Eph 5:15-16 (NRSV) "Be careful then how you live, not as unwise people but as wise, making the most of the time, because the days are evil."

God is in Control of Time

James 4:13-15 (NRSV) "Come now, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a town and spend a year there, doing business and making money. "Yet you do not even know what tomorrow will bring. What is your life? For you are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. Instead you ought to say, "If the Lord wishes, we will live and do this or that."
