- 2 COR. 1:20: FOR ALL THE PROMISES OF GOD IN HIM ARE YEA, AND IN HIM AMEN, UNTO THE GLORY OF GOD BY US.
- Z COR. 7:1: HAVING THEREFORE THESE PROMISES · DEARLY BELOVED, LET US CLEANSE CURSELVES FROM ALL FILTHINESS OF THE FLESH and SPIRIT, PERFECTING HOLINESS IN THE FEAR OF GOD.

THE PROMISES OF GOD

DEFINITION OF PROMISE

- WEBSTER: 1. An assurance that one will or will not do something specified.
 - 2. Something promised.
 - 3. A sign of what may be expected, esp. future development or success.

Synonym - covenant, guarantee, pledge, vow, word.

GOD'S "HOLY WORD" IS ALWAYS A "HOLY PROMISE." Psalm 105.42

- CALL TO OBEDIENCE - GLORY TO GOD!

- Having studied this matter and looked at a few examples from Scripture, when do you think a person needs to claim/lay hold of/or obey the condition of a promise from God?
- What does God want you to do about His promises according to Hebrews 6:12?
- What naturally follows after I claim a promise from God? (II Cor. 6:14-7:1) Note the condition, the promise, and the action to be taken in this passage.
- General promises such as I John 5:11,12, Rev 3:20, John 3:16, etc. are normally very helpful for the new Christian. How has God used these in your life?
- What promises has God given you for. . .
 - your personal life?
 - future?
 - being single?
 - marriage?
 - other areas?

WHAT ARE THE RESULTS OF LIVING BY GOD'S PROMISES?

- Claimed from Isaiah 49:6. Of what benefit was this for Paul?
- Look at Abraham in perhaps the time of greatest need in his life.
 - What was the promise given to Abraham? Look at Genesis 12:1-4; 15:1-6; 17:1-17. Can you see both general and specific promises that God gave Abraham?

- Note Abraham's age when the promise was given & when it was fulfilled.
- What does this in-between time suggest to you?
- Study Genesis 22:1-19. What was God doing here? What enabled Abraham to obey God in a very difficult situation? Cross reference this with Hebrews 11:17-19.

CLAIMING GOD'S PROMISES

- Don't go "yanking" Scripture from anywhere.
- Don't make up your mind what you are going to find before you look into the Scripture.
- Promises are not a cure-all. God is not your magic genie!
- Be convinced of <u>God's ability</u> to perform not your ability to <u>claim</u>.
- Promises are based upon God's character. Num. 23:19, I Kings 8:56.
- Be willing & commit yourself to the conditions involved. "Every promise of God is a summons to action."
- Promises, though they be for a time seemingly delayed, cannot be finally frustrated...the heart of God is not turned though His face be hid; and prayers are not flung back, though they be not instantly answered.
