One by One

- 1 Thessalonians 2:11 (KJV) As ye know how we exhorted and comforted and charged every one of you, as a father doth his children,
- Thessalonians 2:11 (NEB) We dealt with you one by one as a father deals with his children, appealing to you by encouragement as well as by solemn injunction

Scriptural Examples



 - Proverbs 17:22 (NASB77) A joyful heart is good medicine, But a broken spirit dries up the bones.






Another Way ...

- "Partnership"
 - 1 Corinthians 4:17 (NASB77) For this reason I have sent to you Timothy, who is my beloved and faithful child in the Lord, and he will remind you of my ways which are in Christ, just as I teach everywhere in every church.
 - Philippians 2:22 (NASB77) But you know of his proven worth that he served with me in the furtherance of the gospel like a child serving his father

14a I have written to you, fathers, because you know Him who has been from the beginning.

14b I have written to you, <u>young men</u>, because you are strong, and the word of God abides in you, and you have overcome the evil one.
