Fellowship

A. English definition

Three key thoughts or ideas

- (1) Fellowship means being part of a group, a body of people. It is opposed to isolation, solitude, loneliness, and our present day independent kind of individualism.
- (2) Fellowship means having or sharing with others certain things in common such as interests, goals, feelings, beliefs, activities, labor, privileges and responsibilities, experiences, and concerns.
- (3) Fellowship can mean a partnership that involves working together and caring for one another as a community of people, like a company of soldiers or members of a family.

B. Greek

Koinonia translated fellowship 12 times NT is a communal association for the mutual benefit of those involved.

- -"to share or take part together" in a sense of partnership or participation
- -"to share with" in a sense of giving to others

NT usage

 the things shared in common in some way by all parties involved as relationships, blessings, or burdens or responsibilities

- -the person(s) doing the sharing with others
- -the person(s) with whom there is sharing
- an abstract quality of the concept of fellowship, with no object, used alone in Acts 2:42

Short definition; Sharing around the person of Jesus Christ
