 - d. "leave and cleave" "leave" physically, emotionally, financially, religiously. "cleave" means "welded" speaks of permanence and security.

 - a. "an understanding way" The Greek word indicates "investigative knowledge"
 - b. "grant her honor" listen and consider what she has to say.

 - a. "be subject" v.22,24 Greek word "hupotasso" means "to place or rank under", "to obey".
 - 2. <u>Eph. 5:33</u>
 - a. "respect her husband" Greek word is "phobeo"

This word is found 91 times in NASB. This is the only place it is translated "respect". 90 times it is translated in some form of "fear". It is the same Greek word that tells us to "fear" God. So it means to see the husband in his rightful position as "head over the woman".
