#### I. Introduction.

- A. Leaders are not superior to other believers.

#### III. To others.

  - 2. The faint-hearted are to be encouraged.
  - 3. The weak are to be helped—especially the weak in faith. (Romans 14)

#### C. Three attitudes.

- 1. Patience.
- 2. Non-retaliation.
- 3. Helpfulness.

#### IV. To God.

A. In circumstances

- 1. We rejoice. Trials grow us. (James)
- 2. We are to pray. We do not always need someone to help us because we have God's power through prayer.
- 3. We are to rejoice as a testimony to God.

## B. In guidance.

- 1. Do not quench the Spirit's prompting.
- 2. Do not despise the Scripture's wisdom.
  - a. Words need to be tested by the Word of God.
  - b. If the Word does not support something, throw it out.

#### C. In resources.

- 1. God gives us the power to obey.
- 2. We must choose to obey in order to receive the power though.
- 3. We only have a limited time to endure trials and testing. Only what is done through Christ will last.
