A. We have as much of an obligation to be a witness as the greats - Spurgeon, Graham.

1. This is also an opportunity.

B. We ought not to be ashamed of what we are witnessing to.

1. We are not ashamed of telling people our nationality.

2. So too, we should not be ashamed of telling people of Jesus.

C. If we are truly converts of God it ought to be reflected in our countenance.

D. We cannot wait to be a witness.

II. Our witness must be the Holy Spirit working within us, otherwise there is no witness at all.

A. No matter what we do, it will not be a true witness unless it is empowered by the Spirit.

B. We cannot do it by ourselves.
