Now great crowds accompanied him, and he turned and said to them, [26] "If anyone comes to me and does not hate his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. [27] Whoever does not bear his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple. [28] For which of you, desiring to build a tower, does not first sit down and count the cost, whether he has enough to complete it? Otherwise, when he has laid a foundation and is not able to finish, all who see it begin to mock him, saying, 'This man began to build and was not able to finish.' Or what king, going out to encounter another king in war, will not sit down first and deliberate whether he is able with ten thousand to meet him who comes against him with twenty thousand? And if not, while the other is yet a great way off, he sends a delegation and asks for terms of peace. [33] So therefore, any one of you who does not renounce all that he has cannot be my disciple. [34] "Salt is good, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is of no use either for the soil or for the manure pile. It is thrown away. He who has ears to hear, let him hear."

John 15:12 - This is it. Love Others Just As He Loved Us.

John 14:23

Matthew 10:37

The Word of God and the Lord's will for us individually always has a higher priority than the desires and demands of our father and mother spouse and children, and brothers and sisters.

- B. We Must Love Jesus More than Our Father And Mother.
- C. We must Love Him More Than Our Spouse And Our Children.
  - 1. As A Single Person.

- II. A Disciple Puts His Own Selfish Desires Away, Openly Identifies With Jesus Christ. Luke 14:27
  - A. Bear Our Own Cross.
    - 1. Bearing our own cross means dying to our old sinful self and our selfish desires.
    - 2. Bearing our own cross means denying our self's right to rule the throne of our lives on a daily basis, moment-by-moment, decision by decision, calling on the Lord.
