Are you: A Sinner? A Saint? OR A Sinner with a Sin problem? How many of you are in full-time Christian Ministry?

By definition: "Evangelism" refers to the practice of relaying information about a particular set of beliefs to others who do not hold those beliefs.

## Christian evangelism is a PROCESS not a PROCEDURE! John 4:36b

- 1. CULTIVATE by building a trusting friendship. John 13:34-35
- 2. SOW the Word. Romans 10:17
- 3. HARVEST when the Holy Spirit produces the ripe fruit. John 15:5
- 4. DISCIPLE until the PROCESS is repeated:
  - a. as you go

Matthew 28:19-20 – What is the verb?

- b. as His Ambassadors
- 2 Cor. 5:20;
- c. One @ a time
- 2 Timothy 2:2-4

Need <u>Reception & Transmission</u> to get from one Generation to the next.

### What is the best method of evangelism (witnessing for Christ)?

1. You have heard it said, "Preach Christ always and when you must use words."

# Be the LIVING WORD & Speak the WRITTEN WORD! 1 Cor. 10:31 & Rom. 17:11 & 10:17 = Ezra 7:10

- 2. Evangelism is **WHO** you are and **NOT** what you **DO**! Yes, **be His aroma!** 1 Cor. 2:14-15
- 3. Evangelism is best, when you mix good friends with the best biblical technique, when a <u>willing seeker</u> is in contact with a <u>willing sharer</u>. Col. 4:5 Jim Peterson said, "Evangelism is a team sport!"

## What are the "basic" requirements to be a witness for Christ?

- God must give you the <u>faith and the knowledge</u> to know that He exists and that He has spoken through
  - a. His creation

Romans 1:20,

- b. His Word
- 2 Timothy 3:16-17; and
- c. His virgin born Son, Jesus the Christ.
- John 3:16 &14:6;
- 2. The Holy Spirit must convict you of your guilt: How sinful **sin** is; How **righteous** Jesus is & **Judgment** is coming. John 16:8; Rom. 6:23

- 3. The **Holy Spirit** must help you **know and believe** that the **only way** for you to become part of **God's eternal family** is to
  - a. Know God **raised Jesus** from the dead. Rom. 1:3 & **Cor.15:3-6**; At least <u>??</u> people who had seen the resurrected Jesus were still alive, when Paul wrote this letter to Corinth, Greece (Aristotle's home)?

Do not make a "<u>decision</u>" BUT a "<u>commitment</u>" to Put your believe <u>in action</u> to reveal your <u>TRUST</u> in Him!

b. Profess Him as your Lord Rom. 10:9, 10, 13;

c. Repent

Luke 13:3:

d. Receive God's DNA (John 1:12) and be born again John 3:3 to be made righteous. 2 Cor. 5:21

NOW you are a <u>Saint</u> & ready to serve as a <u>Priest!</u>

# What else is needed to become <u>an effective</u> evangelist – a witness for Christ?

- 1. You must know that **you are secure in Him** as <u>His sheep</u>. Are you? John 10:27-30; & Colossians 3:3-4; John 14:20 C. S. Lewis on Rom. 8:29
- 2. You must **let Christ live His life in you** so His **abundant life is visible** to others through you, <u>as you are</u>:
  - **a. His aroma**. Galatians 2:20 & 1 Cor. 2:14-15
  - **b. Controlled** every minute! (1971) Eph. 5:18

## What is needed to continue to grow in effectiveness as a witness for Christ?

- 1. **Stay in the Word**, learn and obey it. (Ezra 7:10 & James 1:22; Psalm 119:105 & 112; Phil. 3:16; John 14:21)
- 2. Keep your **focus on Christ** (2 Corinthians 3: 16-**18**), as the Holy Spirit conforms you <u>more and more</u> into Christ-likeness. (Romans 8:29 & Phil. 2:10 Amp).

- 3. Continue to Love, fellowship, and worship with other Christ-followers, in such a way as to draw others to Christ as He is seen in you! (John 13:34-35 & Heb. 10:24-25)
- 4. Make your election sure to yourself and others! (2 Peter 1:3-9)

# YOU PRODUCE AFTER YOUR OWN KIND! <u>SO</u> BEING is more important than DOING!

Evangelism is most effective in WHO you are; not in WHAT you do!

#### THREE TYPES OF VERBAL WITNESSING:

- 1. Express concern. "I will be praying for you." (John 13:34-35)
- 2. Share your personal testimony. (Philemon 6)
- 3. Take their "spiritual temperature" (1 Peter 3:15-16; share the gospel of Christ (1 Cor. 15:3-6); and ask for a commitment. "Are you ready to: (Luke 13:3; Rom. 10:9,10 &13)

If we do not show concern <u>for a friend</u>, they will think the stranger who speaks up for Christ is <u>a fanatic</u>. Make your life a <u>stepping</u> <u>stone to Christ</u> and not a <u>stumbling block</u>. (1 Cor. 8:13; Col. 4:5)

It may be just as important to re-fire a lukewarm, carnal "Christ-follower" as to win a new one. Behind every inactive Christian is a pre-Christian friend that only he can reach. Yes, a Team Sport." John 4:36b)

The task to reach the world for Christ is not a BIG one, for they must be reached **one by one**. God has **no grand-children** only children.

Not by <u>addition</u> BUT by <u>multiplication</u>! (2 Tim. 2:2-4)

God working through you <u>can and will</u> do all He wants to do through you. (Acts 1:8; 1 Thess. 5:24; then John 14:1-3 & 1 Thess. 4:16-18)

#### REMEMBER:

1. A dead person can do nothing for himself.

(Rom. 6:23; 1 John 5:11-12-13)

2. God did it all. (Rom. 5:8; John 3:16-18 & 2 Cor. 5:21)

3. **Everyone** must come **God's way!** (John 14:6; Luke 13:3; John 3:3; John <u>5:24</u>)

Why do some **NOT** receive life? (John 5:40)

4. **We are a branch** of Jesus! He is the gardener and only pruned branches bear fruit. (John 15:5 &16)

**Keep short accounts with God** (1 John 1:9) **so** you will be able to <u>distinguish between</u> **discipline for correction** and pruning for more Christ-likeness and more fruitful service!

- 5. Use the equipment God has provided:
  - a. **His Word** (2 Tim. 3:16-17);
  - b. His inward urge Holy Spirit (John 16:8); and the
  - c. Outward circumstances. (Col. 4:5)
  - When you line up three lights in a harbor and they become one, you are on course. The same is true with God's equipment.
  - If you are willing to move out when God speaks, tell Him, "Yes!" Then, when He speaks, the very next breath you are on your way with His power at work in you. (Acts 1:8)

NOTE: Your life must be a stepping stone to Christ and not a stumbling block to those who know you. (1 Corinthians 8:13; aroma 2 Corinthians 2:14-15)

## Evangelism is a relationship and fellowship:

- 1. With Christ:
  - a. Who is He historically? (John 3:16; Rom. 1:4)
  - b. Who is He to you? (Rom. 10:9-10)
  - c. Why did he die? For whom? (Rom. 3:23; 6:23)
  - d. What has He done for you? (Rom. 5:8; 1 Peter 7:24; 2 Cor. 5:21; Heb. 10:10; 1 John 5:11-13)
  - e. What is He doing for you now? Rom. 5:7-10; John 10:27-30; Col. 3:3-4; John 14:20; **Heb. 7:25; John 14:1-3**
- 2. With Others:

Christ-followers are God's eternal family. (Romans <u>12:5</u>; Heb. 10:24-25)

Evangelism is a natural fruit of discipleship if we abide in Christ and He

abides in us (John 15:5 &16) and

He keeps praying for us (John 17:45, 20, 24)

He keeps <u>praying for us</u>. (John 17:15, 20, 21) "<u>Christ in you the hope of glory!</u>" Colossians 1:27-29
