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I. Introduction.

II. It means a spirit of forgiveness. (Luke 23:34; Genesis 45:28; 50:20; Exodus 15:22-27)

III. It means a spirit of acceptance. (Luke 23:43)

IV. It means separation from loved ones. (John 19:26-27)

V. It means loneliness. (Matthew 27:46-47)

VI. It means dryness and emptiness. (John 19:28)

VII. It means victory. (John 19:30; 17:4; Revelation 4:5)

VIII. It means surrender. (Luke 23:46)
