I. Introduction.

- A. Christians often fake each other out for different fears.
- B. We who have come to know Jesus Christ are called to be watchman. (Ezekiel 33:8)
- C. A man's previous good deeds will not help him. (Ezekiel 3:20)

II. When the gospel is preached in all the world, then the end will come. It is now possible for the whole world to hear the gospel. (Matthew 24)

III. The gospel needs to be lived and not just learned.

- A. God's objective is to get people saved. (1 Timothy 2:4; 2 Peter 3:9; Luke 19:10)
- B. God's will for the believer is that they become more like Jesus. (Romans 8:29; Ephesians 4:13; John 12:32)
- C. God wants us to be more like Jesus so we can win more people to Jesus. (John 14-17)
- D. The Holy Spirit draws men to Jesus and gives power to witness. (Acts 1:8; John 14)

IV. The church's objective is to give the whole gospel to the whole world.

- A. Through the church, God's manifold wisdom will be known. (Ephesians 3:10)
- B. If we do not tell people about Jesus Christ, no one else will do it.
- C. We are to pray that God would send laborers who know the objective, who know the orders, who are equipped to handle the objective and who get the job done. (Matthew 9:36-38; Ephesians 4:11-12)
