I. Introduction.

- A. The first Christians came up with a summary of their faith: Jesus is Lord.
- B. Lord means master, conqueror and victor.

II. Jesus is either Lord of our life or he is not. We know this by who we are living our lives for.

III. Reasons why we ought to make Jesus Lord of our lives.

- A. Jesus should be Lord of our lives because God said he is Lord. (Colossians 1:15, Philippians 2:6; Acts 2:36)

- C. Jesus should be Lord of our lives because he bought us. (1 Corinthians 6:19-20)
- D. Jesus should be Lord of our lives because he said he was. (John 13:13)
- E. Jesus should be Lord of our lives because it is his destiny. (Philippians 2)
- F. Jesus should be Lord of our lives because his plan is better. (Jeremiah 29:11)
- G. Jesus should be Lord of our lives because of the circumstances of life.
 - 1. Jesus should be Lord of our lives in our choices.
 - 2. Jesus should be Lord of our lives in our challenges.

V. Question and Answers.

- A. Is it better to remain single if you have God's promise to marry.
