- C. There is still hope for you. (Psalm 32:3-5; 1 John 1:9)

V. God is there in the storms of your life right now. (Psalm 107:23-32; 32:7)

- A. Do not limit God in unbelief. (Psalm 78:41)
- B. Whatever your situation, do not give up.
- C. Tell God you will trust him and you will obey.
